## Thurles Fresh Milk 1litre Screw-cap

*After many years in service our popular Tetra Brik 1 litre machine has been ‘retired’.*

We have introduced a new 1 litre screw-cap Tetra carton in its place, which is a 100% plant-based pack and is low in carbon and plastic. Already we have seen this is proving popular with consumers.

## Bonus Shares 2022

*You should by now have received your Annual Share Statement incorporating Bonus Shares approved at our AGM in June and based on Supply and Purchases during 2021. Approximately 387,000 Bonus Shares were allocated as a result.*

Those who traded with the Society received one additional share for every €67 spent; Grain Suppliers received an additional 1.18 shares per tonne supplied and Milk Suppliers received 1 share for every 4,931 litres supplied. This acknowledgement of your loyalty directly translates into a 1.5% rebate on your purchases, €1.18 extra on your tonne of grain and 0.02c per litre of milk supplied.

## Glanbia plc Share Spin-Out

*At a Special General Meeting held at the Society's offices on 5th May 2022, our shareholders voted to transfer in excess of 300,000 Glanbia plc shares, which would have been allocated to the Society, directly to our shareholders instead.*

This was subject to certain terms and conditions. We hope that this process will be completed by mid-August, with our shareholders benefiting to the tune of €3.5m approx. Once again, the value of bonus shares earned by shareholders on an annual basis is enhanced by this spin-out.

## Milk Payment Dates

Over the coming months, Glanbia will be announcing the monthly milk price at a later time than normal. That decision puts additional pressure on ourselves to ensure we have your milk payment in your bank account by the 20th of the month. We achieved this target in July and will actively strive to meet this deadline going forward. To achieve this, we will need to have funds transferred to your bank by 4:00 p.m. on the 19th, so we will need a price decision by 2:00 p.m. If that is delayed for any reason, we may be a day or two late in payment. **We will keep you informed by text should there be any delay.**

To ensure you do not incur difficulties with your bank, could we suggest the following two actions:

- (i) if you are postdating a cheque to be paid against your milk, please date for 22nd of the month rather than 20th, and
- (ii) if you have standing orders for the 20th and 21st of the month that are dependent on your milk payment, consider contacting your bank to change the date back by a couple of days.

For those of you still receiving cheque payments for your milk, we are prioritising posting your milk statement. However, it may now be an opportune time to consider switching to receiving payment directly to your bank account. For those already receiving payment by EFT, you may notice a delay of a couple of days in receiving your milk statement. It will however be up on our MilkedIn App once we have processed the milk statement run.

## Retirement of John Cronin

*At our AGM in June Paddy Daly, our Chairman, acknowledged the retirement of John Cronin from the Committee of Management after 20 years' service.*

He said that John had been an excellent Committee Member and contributor and always debated topics with a level head. He described John as being an absolute gentleman and thanked him for his contribution and support for both the Co-Op and his local Cashel area. The vacancy arising from John's retirement will be filled in due course.

## Micron Agritech Investment

Centenary Thurles has taken a 5% stake in a recent start-up company, Micron Agritech. This company has developed technology which it hopes will revolutionise animal health and diagnostics.

This technology provides for rapid on-site testing of grazing animals for parasites using mobile phones with results received in under 30 minutes. This has the capacity to eliminate the need for herd-wide blanket dosing, which helps avoid medication resistance and saves time and money. We look forward to monitoring progress with this exciting investment.

## Veterinary Regulations

The requirement for a veterinary prescription for antiparasitic medicines and mandatory electronic prescriptions has been deferred from 1st June 2022 to 1st December 2022.




## Climate Change Training

## Inflation



## Introducing White Clover Good for production and the environment

*Reducing inputs is a crucial part of today's sustainable livestock farming systems. Able to supply up to 150kg nitrogen/ha, white clover reduces the need for artificial fertiliser and cost of application without impacting grass yield.*

Research from Teagasc shows a potential 8% reduction in fertiliser use between now and 2030 through improved soil pH and increased clover content in pasture swards.

A high - quality and digestible plant, white clover also supports higher animal feed intakes and enhanced performance. Research shows less fertiliser is required to produce the same amount of herbage from a clover/ grass sward:

### Benefits of white clover:

- Improves grazing quality
- Drives dry matter (DM) intake in summer and autumn
- Increases milk production and liveweight gain
- Fixes atmospheric nitrogen making it available for plant growth
- Lowers the need for N fertiliser application in summer
